I formed SALT (Strategic Asia Leadership Team) to be a catalyst and a coordinating group to engage Asia in fulfilling the Great Commission. Keith, my brother, moved to China as an English teacher at a university. He currently lives in Nanchang, Jiangxi, China.

🗓 2005

We formed e3 Leadership Group as a non-profit 501c3 ministry to enter Creative Access Countries; organize and send short-term mission and one-year study abroad projects; partnering with churches/ministries in Asia; Healthy Indigenous Leader Development training and coaching.

🗓 2006 to Current

During these years we led short-term missions and Healthy Leader Trainings to many Asian countries and established a number of partnerships with Asian churches

🗓 2011

We helped place a missionary family in Hong Kong.

🗓 2012

Our International Student Ministry - held its first annual conference in Omaha NE. We helped a Philippines - Micro Loans project.

🗓 2013

A church plant team from Texas moved to China. In Taiwan, a bilingual church plant team started New Heart Church in Taichung, Taiwan. We helped place one-year missionaries in Tokyo with the goal of becoming permanent missionaries to Japan.

🗓 2014

An American Team of six from Colorado went to China for a One Year Study Abroad. Two Americans went to Taiwan for an Asian internship. Doug went full-time.

🗓 2015

We helped a missionary family from Texas to move to Japan for the long term.

🗓 2016

As a result of this summer's mission projects, we have established "Gospel Beachheads in nine of thirteen Key cities in China. We helped send a family from Loveland CO to China for four years.

🗓 2017

We established new partnerships in Nepal with ongoing training four times per year

🗓 2018

We sent a team of three Americans to Hong Kong for a two-year mission

📍 2019

We now disciple with Chinese Professors who have become believers. We have started 3 new projects: Clean Water Filters, Eye-Glass Clinics, and Healthy Leader Scholarships. We also started our online leader mentoring with participants from four Asian countries.

📍 2020 - 2022 — The Covid Years

Due to Covid, The Lord closed doors for in-person training and short-term mission trips. Yet, the Lord open new doors of opportunities through many on-line Zoom trainings. We now are engaged in training hundreds of House church pastors, leaders from India, Nepal, and China. As a result of building into multiple church leaders and members, we have been indirectly involved in seeing hundreds of men and women saved, baptized, disciplined and churches planted in unreached people groups. We started Great Commission Asia Summit: on-line. This is now an annual one-day ZOOM Asia conference. We have had hundreds of attendees for this conference.

📍 2023

Now that countries have reopened for travel, we have renewed our in-person short-term mission trips and leader development/disciple training. Currently we have re-engaged in-person training/partnerships with Nepal, Philippines, Hong Kong and Taiwan. Also, Doug became a certified facilitator with SDI 2.0 (CoreStrengths - Strength Development Inventory) which build high-trust teams based on Relational Intelligence. This enables us to deepen our training and also expand our training into the business and educational world.

📍 2024

8 Zoom Trainings per week with house church leaders and maturing disciples through the Word.

We lead short-term mission trips 2-3 times per year. During these trips, we host an eyeglass clinic where we examine people's eyes and then give them brand-new glasses with the appropriate magnification. This is life-changing!

While people are waiting we have the privilege to share the Gospel. So, we are working on both the demonstration of the Gospel of Grace and the proclamation of the Gospel.

We started an Asia network of pastors, which we call Great Commission Asia Network. In this network, we pray, listen and plan together on how to expand the Kingdom of God. Also, this year we are developing a ministry called 'Migrant Missionary Initiative'. Many indigenous people in Asia acquire work outside of their home country and then send support back home. We are working with Asian churches to better prepare these men and women to be on mission overseas.
